**LIONS**

*Today's Lions clubs began on June 7, 1917 as the dream of Chicago businessman Melvin Jones. He felt that existing business clubs should expand their horizons from purely professional concerns to the betterment of their communities and the world at large. It became Lions clubs International when the first club in Canada was established in 1920.*

*On April 9, 1923 a meeting was held in the city of Phoenix, in our neighboring state of Arizona. With the two cities of Albuquerque and Phoenix serving as a nucleus, There was established an entirely new District with the numerical designation of District 21, Lions International, which was composed of the states of New Mexico and Arizona, and a portion of the state of California.*

*In 1928 New Mexico held their first state convention as Lions Clubs International District 40 . Today NM has two Districts 40 South and 40 North.*
